

Squash League Appeals Committee 2011

There are currently 6 club representatives who serve on this committee. They are; Hugh Alexander (Petersfield), Graham Dawes (Petersfield), Stan Thornton (Trojans) Farooq Mirza (Nuffield Health), George Kouseff (Winchester), Elvin Booth (Lee)

The Appeals procedure is:

1. LMS flags up that the rules might have been infringed.
2. League secretary examines the results.
3. If League secretary decide the rules have been broken, he penalises clubs where necessary by deducting points on LMS
4. League secretary notifies club(s) of penalty by email (decision is also flagged up on LMS) and gives them 14 days to appeal.
5. If Club(s) appeals League secretary selects 3 of the 6 committee who will act as the appeals panel for the particular case, if possible three who have no connection (eg same club, same division) with the case.
6. League secretary then collates the evidence; (ie. match result, decision process, the appeal from the penalised club(s)) and e-mails it to the 3-person panel, copied also to the club(s).
7. The appeals panel make their decision, by email discussion, which League secretary then e-mails to the club(s) concerned.
8. The League secretary will produce a summary of all appeals for each Hants SRA committee meeting.
9. In exceptional cases the penalised clubs can ask that the decision be reviewed by the Hants SRA committee. Exceptional cases are those where there is conflicting evidence between two clubs which requires further investigation. It will not include those cases involving a breach of the League rules by a single club.
10. It is at the discretion of the Hants SRA committee whether it asks or agrees to a personal hearing by the club(s) concerned.
