## Comments

Hampshire made a good start defeating Warwickshire 5 – 0. Comfortable 3-0 wins for Jamie and Tom. Jack and Oliver recovered from losing the opening games to record 3-1 wins. Jacques fought back from trailing 2-1 to win 3-2.

Gloucestershire had defeated Sussex in their opening match so the match between Hampshire and Gloucestershire would be crucial to the outcome of the weekend. Hampshire made a great start with Oliver taking the first game 11/8 at No.5 string and Tom winning 3-1 at No.3 string. However, Oliver lost the next two games narrowly 9/11 8/11 and eventually the match 1-3. This made it one match won by each County. Jacques made a good start for Hampshire at No.4 string taking the first game 11/6 and Jamie recovered from two games down to make it 2 games all. Unfortunately, Hampshire's chances faded as Jamie lost 8/11 in the fifth and Jacques lost 11/13 in the fourth. Jack lost 0-3 to complete the 1-4 defeat. Gloucestershire just needed to defeat Warwickshire to win the group. This they did comfortably 5-0. As the top team they now progress to the Finals in March.

Hampshire's final match of the day was against Sussex. This would decide 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> positions. Though Hampshire had defeated Sussex 5-0 in Stage 1 in November this time Hampshire were without Jamie who complained of a hamstring strain just prior to the match and so was withdrawn. This meant that all players moved up a place and Harvey moved up to No. 5 string. Sussex had a couple of reserve players and so they played against Robbie Keefe and Kyle Finch of Hampshire, who had both been present supporting the team. Both Robbie and Kyle won 3-0. In the match itself only Tom maintained his 100% record. Now playing at No.2 string Tom won 3-0 and so was undefeated all day. Jack, playing at No.1 string, was unfortunate to be on the end of some questionable refereeing decisions in his match. This resulted in him losing the third game 12/14 when the match was 1 game each. Jack did not recover and went on to lose 1-3. Jacques and Harvey both lost 0-3 and so Sussex took the match 4-1.

So Hampshire finished third behind Sussex and Gloucestershire. Warwickshire finished 4th
