Hants League Appeal Procedures and Committee

1. The League Organiser will administer the league according to the current League Rules.
2. If any club disagrees with the League Organiser's interpretation of the rules, they may appeal to the Appeals Committee through the League Organiser. Any appeal in respect of a match must be made in writing within 14 days of the match or, if in relation to the record on LMS, within 14 days of its posting on LMS.
3. The League Organiser will put the evidence before the Appeals Committee explaining how and why he/she came to that decision.
4. The Appeals Committee will consider the evidence and decide whether or not they agree with the decision. The decision will then be communicated to the penalised club. If the club still disagrees with the decision/penalty they have 14 days in which to respond and appeal to the Hants SRA, explaining why they believe the decision is wrong.
5. The League Organiser will then put the evidence and decision making to the Hants SRA for a final decision.
6. There will be no appeal against the decision of the Hants SRA.
